ADMISSION POLICY

REF: SCHOOL CHARTER ORIGINATED BY ALET

- 1) The AP shall be formulated by the ALET.
- 2) The AP shall comply with CBSE/State Govt. guidelines.
- 3) The Principal shall make admissions as per AP.
- 4) The optimum strength of class be kept within 40 and not less than 35.
- 5) The ALET has recommended that the school shall allot 80% of the seats in a class to the wards of AL employees.
- 6) The remaining seats (20%) shall be allotted to wards of general category (i.e. other public of Hosur). This ratio can be amended by the Trust as per the requirement.
- 7) The Trust shall comply with RTE obligations and make provision for the same in its admission.
- 8) The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009, obligation (effect on 1 April 2010):
 - School shall reserve 25% of the seats for RTE quota.
 - School shall admit them in addition to the 35 seats in a class.
 - RTE admissions are based on the following guidelines:
 - Age: 6-14 years.
 - Neighborhood - Primary - 1 Km.
 - Middle/High School - 3 kms.
 - No vacancy available in the nearby Govt.School.
 - Salary of the parent less than 2 lakhs per annum.
- 9) Admission to LKG is by lots method.
- 10) Admission to other classes is based on vacancy, sibling preference and teacher's child and entrance test performance or excellence in co-scholastic areas
